



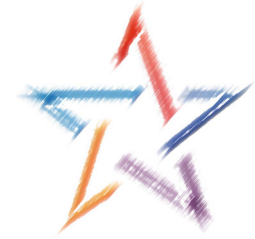

For Maria Von Trapp, it was “raindrops on roses, and whiskers on kittens” that provided the imagery for a vision of goodness and beauty to balance her day-to-day difficulties.

Artists, however, invoke favorite things with a more transcendent purpose – to transform the ordinary into something beyond; to render the Profane, Sacred; to bring a viewer into an enchanted vision of some thing beyond its quotidian state, and, thus, allow our minds to rise. It must be so, or we could have no great paintings of an apple or a flower, a humble landscape, or an average face. To capture a viewer, we would have always to paint the fantastic, the bizarre – portraits could only be of super models and the extraordinarily beautiful.

It is Composition and Design – color, tonality, rhythms and repetitions – that provides the framework for the Artist’s transcendent vision allowing us, for a moment or two, to put aside “the dog’s bite and the bee’s sting”.
